

HON 180 and the HONORS MATH REQUIREMENT

All Honors Program students are required to have the equivalent of HON 180 or better to satisfy the Honors Math/Statistics requirement. The prerequisite for HON 180 is ISP 120 OR MAT 130.

Honors Program students will be **exempt** from HON 180 **if** :

- 1) They have a calculus or statistics requirement as a part of their major. This includes students in the following majors:
 - Mathematics
 - Economics
 - Psychology or Sociology or Public Policy
 - Commerce
 - Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or Environmental Science
 - CDM students with an IT 223 requirement
- 2) They have AP Calculus or AP Statistics credit.
- 3) They are a non-Commerce student planning to minor in Commerce. These students will replace HON 180 with MAT 242 or MAT 137. Or they plan to minor in Psychology or Sociology and will replace HON 180 with PSY 240 or SOC 279.

If none of these exemptions apply, students **must** take HON 180 at some point during their first six quarters.

CDM students may substitute IT 223 for HON 180 if it is already a required part of their major. CDM students who are NOT required to take IT 223 or a calculus-sequence as part of their major *must* take HON 180.
