Who Can Enter

Current DePaul students may enter work written in Spring '15, Summer '15, Fall '15, and Winter '16 for the following courses:

- FYSW 102
- WRD 102, 103, and 104, and 104x
- Focal Point Seminars
- Discover and Explore Chicago
- Honors 100
- Quantitative Reasoning

Texts may include

- Essays (including narrative, analytical, reflective, critical, researched, and others)
- Digication Portfolios
- Digital Projects
- Reports and interviews from field work

- You will then receive further instructions via email on how to upload your entry to a specific Digication Community site based on your entry type (individual essay, portfolio, multimodal project, etc.).
- Writers may submit up to two writing projects any time before the deadline of Wednesday, April 6, 2016.
